## **Some Notes on the Resurrection**



Greetings to everyone in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ! He is our risen Lord and Savior, and we are about to celebrate the day when God the Father gloriously raised God the Son out of the tomb.

What is resurrection?

Perhaps the straightest definition of a resurrection is this (not mine): when a person who has died is restored physically back to life as that same person.

In fact, there are ten instances of completed resurrections recorded in the Bible (3 Old Testament, 7 New Testament). Resurrection is mentioned/occurs four more times in the Book of Revelation, but they have yet to occur.

Job (perhaps as early as 2000 BC) gives the oldest recorded mention of the resurrection:

*And after my skin has been thus destroyed,  
yet in my flesh I shall see God,  
whom I shall see for myself,  
and my eyes shall behold, and not another.  
My heart faints within me! (Job 19:26-27)*

In 869 BC, Elijah performs the first resurrection mentioned in the Bible (1 Kings 17:22).

Yet bar none, the most important resurrection occurs on the morning (most likely) of April 5, 33 AD. Because on that morning, after Jesus had been crucified on the cross, the one undeniable historical fact is that the tomb was empty! This is such an impeccably (pun intended) attested event that all reputable historians and serious scholars (both Christian and atheist) agree on the empty tomb. In fact, the earliest wording describing the event (mentioned in 1 Corinthians 15:3-8) likely began to be disseminated by the Church within a few months of Jesus' resurrection! But what makes Jesus' resurrection even more wonderful is that He has made this available to us! As Jesus declares:

***“I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you had known me, you would have known my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him.”*** (John 14:6-7)

This is the Good News—that Jesus not only defeated Satan, sin and death, He then made resurrection available for us to receive in faith!

What wonderful news, friends! What a joyful and glorious (future) resurrection the Lord has won for us!

This is why Resurrection Sunday is the most important celebration of the Christian calendar! This year, it will occur on the same dates as the original event! I am excited to invite everyone to join us for our week-long thanksgiving and celebration!

March 29<sup>th</sup> is our **Palm Sunday** worship service—the day when Jesus openly entered Jerusalem as the Messiah!

April 3<sup>rd</sup> at 12 PM is our **Good Friday** service (often referred to as “Tenebrae,” the service of darkness/shadows).

April 5<sup>th</sup> at


- 7:30 AM is our Early Resurrection service at Bay Hill Beach

- 10:00 AM Resurrection Sunday Worship
- 11:30 AM Easter Egg Hunt for our children!

I end with these words from Jesus, again speaking of the resurrection!

***“I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die. Do you believe this?”***  
(John 12:25-26)


