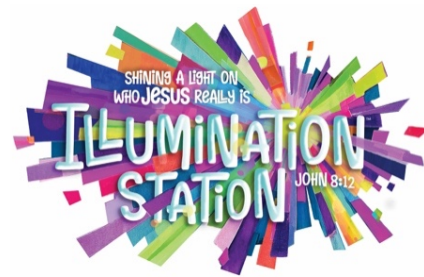


SUMMER CAMP: Illumination Station will be June 29 to July 3, 9am to 12pm each day. Registration forms are by the gym and on Central's website.
