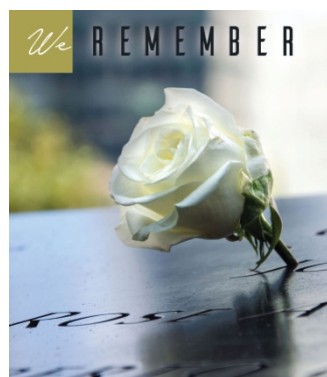
Elder On Call for September is Rich Goetz, 631-266-2487.
